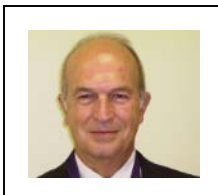

District Deputy November December Report

We have completed one the first three months of Council Year 2009 -2010. The District installations have all been held with good attendance for all of them. The new grand Knights are getting their feet wet and learning all of the intricacies of their job and its responsibilities.

Supreme has instituted a sixth Program Pro-Life. The requirements for this program are the same as they are for Church, Community, Council, Family and Youth. This means at least one Pro-Life activity per quarter and a Pro-Life Chairman.

The State Council has also changed the Service Program procedures. In the past the District Deputy had the responsibility of getting the quarterly Surge Reports to the Program Director. He still must approve and sign the reports but it is now the Grand Knights responsibility to ensure that the reports are submitted in a timely manner. This will cut the time that the Council has to prepare the reports because the District Deputy still must sign them. As you know membership is the lifeblood of every Council. This year Supreme has increased from 6% to 7% of membership as of July 1st membership to achieve STAR Council. District 5 conducted 1st degrees on 9/14 at SKD 14011, and 10/8 at Pangborn 1365. A 2nd degree at SKD on 10/14 lead to a 3rd degree on 10/25 at Pangborn; where candidates packed the house! The chances on the 2010 Ford Mustang went well; with Councils earning sixty cents for every ticket sold. The winner was Pedro A. Calderone of Gaithersburg, MD, the winning ticket was sold by Council 13463.

The District turnout for the Columbus Day Ball was outstanding. I thought I had gone out on a limb by reserving three tables but in the end had a fourth table.

The June 09 issue of Medical Economics magazine features an article by Barry James Dyke the author of "The Pirates of Manhattan" which is currently on the NY Times best seller list.
